







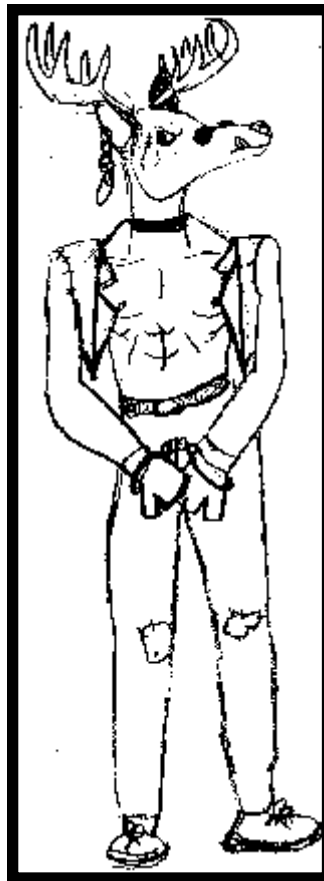
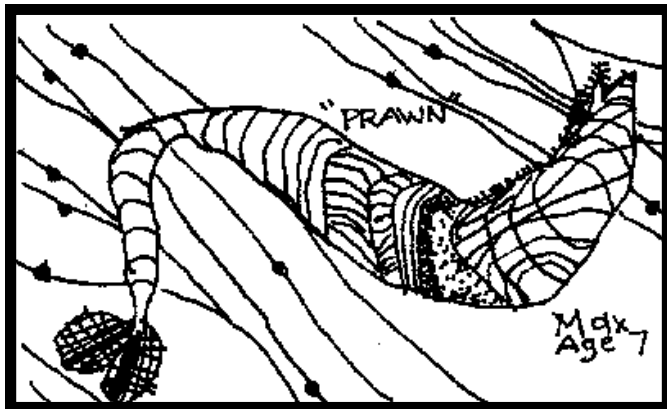


PHILOSOPHY

PROGRAMS

Programs vary from term to term so that children don’t become bored. They also vary from Juniors to Intermediates to Seniors to allow for age/ability/interest differences. All programs include some of the following:

-  Learning to really look and see.
-  Where to start a drawing and how to construct it.
-  Pattern and composition.
-  Portraiture/The body.
-  3D/Perspective (Intermediates)
-  Far and Near (Juniors)
-  Animals/Fantasy animals.
-  Different types of art (Surrealism, Cubism, Impressionism etc).
-  Cartooning.
-  Colour.
-  Imagination and fantasy.
-  Some 3D/Sculpture work.

All lessons include short sessions on talking about art.

Classes have a maximum of 10 children. All materials are supplied so children don't need to bring anything except a drink and a snack if they want one.

An adult may stay for the first few classes if their child "gets the wobbles" when going to something new.

Classes cost \$13 each. This can be paid as a term fee or lesson by lesson, so long as the whole fee has been paid by the end of the term. A \$5 discount is offered to each child who pays the whole term fee at the first lesson of that term.

New students may come for 3 lessons on a pay-as-you-come basis for a trial. On the fourth lesson, if they continue with classes, they are financially committed for the rest of the term. This, however does not need to be paid up front and can still be paid on a weekly basis. The \$5 discount is still offered if the rest of the term is paid for at this fourth lesson.
